Learning Objectives

Participants learn why to use, when to use and how to analyze fundamental tools to include run charts, histograms, Pareto charts, and scatter plots. Participants will leave with guidance for how to build each of these tools using simple Excel.

This workshop has been requested repeatedly at the national and regional levels throughout the country and at numerous various healthcare institutions. Improvement is both a science and an art.

We've learned a lot about both aspects which we can make good use of to increase the rate of improvement. The second half of our day we will explore crucial lessons learned related to making improvement happen faster!

Participants walk away understanding key leverage points to accelerate improvement including clarity of aim, use of a pilot population, measurable goals, use of the driver diagram, useful measurement, multiple ways of getting ideas more likely to lead to improvement, and the power of testing changes prior to implementation by using many small PDSA cycles. A variety of tools will be provided for participant's take-away use.
