










## Darling Ducklings List of Supplies

- A picture of your child
  - 2 boxes of tissues
    - Bag of diapers
  - 2 boxes of wipes
- 2 sheets and blanket for the crib
  - Daily food
  - Daily snacks
  - Daily bottles
  - powder/creams/ointments
    - shoebox for belongings
  - complete change of clothes



• 5 bibs for the week \*\*Please make sure you label everything with your child's first and last name.\*\*



Dear Parents,

All of the children's belongings <u>MUST be clearly labeled at all times</u> with your child's first and last name. This is a NYS regulation. Many of the children's bottles, cups, bowls, lunch boxes, etc., although originally labeled, are not clearly visible at all times. Additionally, the names need to be on the sides; not the bottom, of each item so that their full name is visible at all times. This regulation is meant to protect our children.

There is a company called **Name Bubbles at namebubbles.com** that sells labels that are dishwasher safe and meant to last a long time. They also offer labels for sheets, blankets, backpacks, etc. We are asking that you consider purchasing these labels or a similar product to ensure our children's safety.

Our staff will not be allowed to accept any items for your children that are not in compliance with this regulation.
