Our class name is the Lovable Lions and our class will be in Room #5.

This school year will be filled with lots of fun and learning! Throughout the year we will be learning how to identify and write the letters of the alphabet, each child's first and last name, and numbers 1-20. Each week we will learn a new letter and number, including letter sounds to help prepare for reading. These skills will also be reinforced through homework that is sent home once a week.
