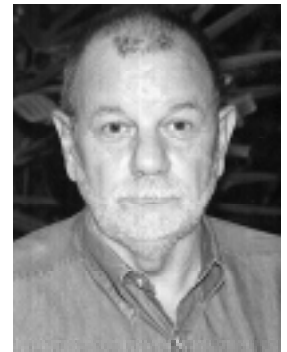
agreed to serve as needed as consultants to our new staff for which we are indeed grateful.
