It is provided that this contract may be terminated (in whole or in part) for any one or more of such reasons by written notice from one party to the other without liability within 0 - 90 days prior to the event and if 25% or more of the participants are unable to attend. No penalties will apply to Group if the event has to be cancelled due to an impending hurricane.

In the event the Florida Healthcare Engineering Association cancels the seminar less than 6 months of the presentation date, the Florida Healthcare Engineering Association is fully responsible for any fees and travel expenses incurred by the speaker, including the contracted speaker fee, if applicable.

In the event that the speaker cancels the seminar less than six months prior to the scheduled presentation date, the Florida Healthcare Engineering Association has no financial responsibility to the speaker, including any pre-paid, non-refundable travel expenses. If the Florida Healthcare Engineering Association has incurred any non-refundable expenses relative to meeting any of the requirements set for the by the speaker, the speaker agrees to reimburse the Florida Healthcare Engineering Association for any of those expenses, including meeting room rental fees, audiovisual fees, travel expenses, etc.
