FDA Further Defines “Facility” for Drug Compounding

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) recently issued final guidance clarifying that an organization may operate both a compounding pharmacy and an outsourcing facility at the same general location if they are completely segregated by clearly defined boundaries, such as walls or doors that are locked. If the pharmacy is not completely segregated from the outsourcing facility, the FDA would generally consider the pharmacy part of the outsourcing facility and subject to 503B of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and current manufacturing practice, the agency stated. Both compounders also should clearly label their drug products as compounded at a pharmacy or outpatient facility, the FDA stated.

Agencies Streamline N95 Respirator Regulation

A final order exempting manufacturers from FDA premarket notification requirements for certain N95 respirators, disposable devices used to protect patients, and healthcare providers from infection was recently issued by the FDA. Under a new memorandum of understanding (MOU), among the FDA, the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH), and others, organizations seeking to market N95 respirators that do not exceed certain criteria need only NIOSH certification. The final order and MOU are intended to streamline regulatory requirements to help an adequate supply of the devices during emergencies.

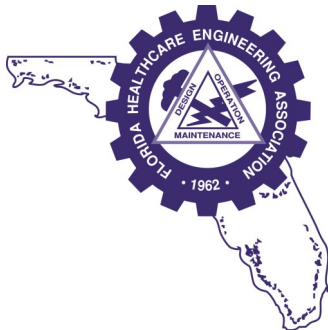
