ENGINEER OF THE YEAR GUIDELINES

Any member in good standing wishing to nominate a candidate to be considered for the “Engineer of the Year” should present to his District President the background and accomplishments of the healthcare engineer. A committee of three (3) shall be appointed by the District President. They will review the submitted applicants and select a candidate most suited to be the District’s Engineer of the Year Award nominee. The committee will submit the name of the person selected as the most deserving of this award to the District Secretary who in turn shall forward the name and background papers of the applicant chosen to the State Secretary before the Annual Meeting. The State Engineer of the Year Committee will select the nominee to receive the honor.

For a nominee to be considered as Engineer of the Year, he must be an active member of the FHEA and a CHE. In the event a nominee were to retire or obtain other employment outside the Engineering field, that nominee would still be eligible to receive the Engineer of the Year for that calendar year only.
