

Teaching + Exam Syllabus

- GuildExam incorporates both teaching + examination syllabus together. Teachers can **continue to use the books they are currently using** in the classroom, as most of these books are in the syllabus or they may apply as “own choice”
- Students can choose their favourite pieces as their exam pieces. This **reduces the tension** they may normally feel during exam.
- This **saves cost** as students do NOT need to buy separate examination books



“OWN CHOICE” SYSTEM

- Students may lose interest when confronted with an uncompromising selection of works. Thus, the introduction of “Own Choice” system. It highlights the basis of **no one person is the same as another**.
- Students are allowed to choose their own pieces to play for exam.

“OWN CHOICE” – How to apply ?

- Email your selection – first 2 pages and state the Level of your application.
- Level of difficulties equivalent to the technical requirements set for each Level
- GuildExam will reply within 10days :-
 - If approved, it can be used for exam. (Keep the approval letter as reference)
 - If not approved, students are required to select other choices.
 - No charges involved.

It is advisable to obtain approval prior to examination preparation. In the event when approval is not granted, you will still have time to make changes.




Professional Performance (equivalent to Associate level)

Diploma in Public Performance (equivalent to Licentiate level)

Pieces

1 Accuracy (30%) + or -

- Correct notation, rhythm and tempo.
- Technical control of the instrument.

2 Continuity and Fluency (30%) + or -

- Clarity of presentation and content.☑
- Convincing tempo and feel for the style.
- Ability to produce focused and consistent tone as required by the composer.
- No hesitation – Think about phrasing/style/mood/tempo

3 Musical sense (30%) + or -

- It is essential to be aware of style of music being performed.
- Ability to control and contrast dynamics in relation to style and meaning.
- Varying colour and phrasing in ways that enhance rhythmic character and which are supportive of the composer's intention.

4 Overall performance (10%) + or -

This marking is used by examiners to record holistic impression of candidates' ability to integrate the skills, knowledge, and awareness and the degree to which they can produce and present their work. Such includes: showing cohesion, spontaneity, creativity, individuality and personal investment. But final assessment is based on all of the above factors plus the performer's ability and reaction.
