

Doula Canada Code of Conduct

Doula Canada Practitioners shall:

WITH RESPECT TO COMPETENT PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE:
Will actively work toward certification in a timely manner.

Maintain good personal hygiene and maintain hygienic premises, facilities and equipment that conform to professional health standards.

Maintain accurate and up-to-date record of dates of clients and/or classes; names, addresses, email and phone number of each student, and complete financial records as required by law.

Refer to other qualified health care practitioners when services required are outside the practitioner's scope of practice.

Make no disparaging remarks concerning the practices, abilities or competence of other practitioners in other health disciplines.

Not make a verbal or written statement which is fraudulent or false in a material respect, or omit to disclose any material, fact or matter and thereby engage in unethical conduct.

Not engage in sexual or other harassment or exploitation of clients, students or colleagues.

Not disclose, prescribe or claim to cure.

WITH RESPECT TO CONFIDENTIALITY:

Respect confidential information obtained in the course of professional practice except where disclosure is required by law. Obtain written or verbal consent from a client and/or student before photographing, video-taping, audio recording or permitting a third party observation.

WITH RESPECT TO FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

Not submit any fraudulent, deceitful or misleading bill for services rendered or to be rendered.
Submit fees in a timely manner.
