Entry Information: Entries for Championship, Premiership, AOV, and Provisional classes must have the registration number on the entry blank and printed in the catalog. All Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded HHPs, and registered cats competing as HHPs with a HHP color class prefixes will be scored for CFA Awards. No Adult, AOV, MISC, or PROV Entry will be accepted without a CFA registration number. Entry clerk will phone collect to clarify entries when necessary. Benching requests will be honored whenever possible. One request or Agent per exhibitor. NO NEGATIVE REQUESTS. ALL Fees MUST accompany a signed ENTRY.

CFA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. CFA Show Rules may be obtained by sending \$7 to CFA, 260 E Main St., Alliance, OH 44601 or by going online to: www.cfa.org/Portals/0/documents/forms/18-19show-rules.pdf

REMEMBER: when sending entries by Electronic methods, **ALL your Entry Fees MUST be paid within ten (10) days of receipt or at check-in; whichever comes first, per CFA Show Rules.** The show management reserves the right to add judges not named to judge non-Championship and non-Premiership classes.

Entries & Fee: Make Checks payable to: **Crown City Cat Club** or use **PayPal**. No refund for failure to bench. No postdated checks. \$50 charge for returned checks. For sale entries must accompany at least one competitive entry. No posting of cat/kitten selling prices allowed. No kitten(s) under the age of 4 months will be allowed in the show hall. For entry clarification, the entry clerk may call collect.

How to Pay via PayPal: Go to **PayPal.com** and select "SEND." Enter the following email address: **CrownCityCatClub@aol.com** Enter the amount due making sure to select (USD) as the type of funds. **Click: FRIENDS or FAMILY.** (Do NOT click "Goods or Services" - any additional PayPal fees **will** be charged back to the exhibitor at check in.) Please provide the exhibitor's name (not the entry name) in the comments section before completing your payment.

New Exhibitors: You should bring a towel or rug for the floor of the cage and enough fabric to go around three sides and cover the top of the cage. ALL CATS MUST BE BROUGHT IN A CARRIER. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry.

Hotel: Motel 6 (use CFA code OAPHHT for discount - No Pet Fee), Red Roof Inn (use CFA code 526223 for discount – No Pet Fee), La Quinta (use CFA code CATFAN9 for discount – No Pet Fee), Super 8 Motel, Best Western, Vagabond Inn, and Travel Lodge. Hotels may require a small pet deposit.

Show Hall: Ontario Oaks Middle School: 1221 S Oaks Ave., Ontario, CA 91762. The hall is air-conditioned & heated, non-smoking, & handicapped accessible. ALCOHOL is not allowed on school property - please do not bring any to the show. SMOKING is not allowed on school property.

Directions to Show Hall:

From I-10: Exit Mountain and go South. Turn West (right) onto Mission Bl. Turn Left onto Oaks. Oaks Middle School will be on your left (East) after about 1/4 mile.

From CA-60: Exit Mountain and go North. Turn West (left) onto Mission Bl. Turn Left onto Oaks. Oaks Middle School will be on your left (East) after about 1/4 mile.

Check In is from 8:00-9:00 am Saturday. Any entry not checked in by 9:00 am will be marked absent. Judging will begin promptly at 9:30 am Saturday and 9 am Sunday. Show hours are to 5 pm both days.

Benching: **LARGE SINGLE CAGES** will be used at this show. All spaces are 36 inches wide with wire cages being 27" high and 24" deep. *If your Security Cage does not fit in the space provided, you must order additional space (i.e. groom space) prior to the close of the show - additional space will not be provided at the show.* One cat or 2 kittens per cage in accordance with CFA show rules. For sale cats/kittens must be from the same owner. Entry form is required for all "For Sales" and must be accompanied by at least one competitive entry with the same owner.

Litter will be provided. Bring your own cat food, dishes and litter pans.

Food: Lunches and desserts will be available for sale in the show hall. Grand Parties are allowed.

NO Alcohol and NO Smoking Allowed on School Property.

Health: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, and ear mites. All claws must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not allowed for entry per CFA show rules.

Awards: Ribbons and awards will be given according to CFA show rules. Permanent awards may be used for class awards. Fabric ribbons will be available upon request.

Neither Crown City Cat Club nor the Ontario Oaks Middle School will be responsible for damage, loss, personal injury, or loss of personal property. No cat may be left overnight in the show hall. There will be no vending from cages or groom spaces.
