

2018 MACCC Composition Scholarship Contest

Prizes include 1st Prize: \$200, 2nd Prize: \$100, Honorable Mentions, plus the possibility of a live performance of the winning compositions at the conference concert of the 2018 MACCC Conference in San Diego

Contest Rules

- Any currently enrolled California Community College music student is eligible, *unless the student has previously won first place in the MACCC Composition Competition*
- Compositions entered may be of any style or genre.
- Scoring should be for 1-7 performers in any combination of instruments or voices.
- Length: 8 minutes maximum
- Composition must have been completed between the start of the Fall of 2016 semester and the August 31, 2018 submission deadline.
- Composition must be notated.
- An active member of MACCC must approve the contest entry form.
- Each composition requires a \$20 entry fee.
- If a winning composition includes MIDI or other electronic media, winner must provide a CD or digital recording for performance.
- Travel to, and accommodations at, the conference are the responsibility of the winner.

Compositions will be judged on quality, originality, clarity of notation, performability, and adherence to contest rules. All student composers will receive written comments on their pieces.

Submission Requirements:

1. Score (Scores produced with notation software are preferred. Neatly hand-written scores are also acceptable.)
2. Audio recording of the composition (CD or other digital format). If the student intends to perform his/her composition at the conference, the submitted recording must be of the student's performance.
3. Completed contest entry form with faculty sponsor's signature. (see below)
4. \$20 entry fee (make check payable to MACCC)
