

# From the Pastor's Pen



**Pentecost** 

**CAN'T DO IT ON OUR OWN.** Today we're blessed with a deeper realization of how much our Christian faith is rooted in Judaism: Jesus, of course, was Jewish, so was Mary, and so were all of the characters we hear about in the early chapters of the Acts of the Apostles. Early Jewish Christians recognized Jesus as the promised Messiah. Believing in him as God's beloved Son, they were not betraying their Jewish heritage but living it to the full.

What then of the non-Jews, the Gentiles? What if they were drawn to Jesus? This was **the** burning question of the first generation of Christians.



Peter, Paul and Barnabas had to struggle their way through this. It wasn't just a thought process. They needed the Holy Spirit.

The Church leaders had to call a crucial meeting in Jerusalem to settle things, which we hear about in today's reading.

After what Luke, the author of Acts, notes politely as "no little discussion and debate," the assembly agreed God made "no distinctions" among peoples. The Gentiles had a place in the community of Jesus. This was God's will prompted by the Spirit of Jesus. The assembly sent out a letter to the followers of Jesus announcing this decision.

Hearts open to God's Spirit, respecting people of different backgrounds, understanding how God

embraces all people—this is the why we beg for the Holy Spirit.

**PENTECOST NOVENA BEGINS** this coming Friday. After Jesus ascended to the Father's right hand, the disciples gathered in prayer in the Upper Room. During nine days they faithfully waited. Finally, on the tenth day the Spirit descended upon them with force.

This is the origin of the word and practice of the *novena*, from the Latin for *ninth day*.

Next Sunday is the Ascension, but the Feast is displaced from the Thurs before the 6<sup>th</sup> wk of Easter, 40 days after the Resurrection.

On May 4, 1897, Pope Leo XIII proclaimed: "We decree and command that throughout the whole Catholic Church, this year and in every subsequent year, a novena shall take place before Pentecost, in all parish churches." This is no longer a mandate from the Pope, but it remains an excellent practice.

**Praying the Pentecost Novena** prepares us for a New Pentecost. We receive better the things we prepare for by anticipation. Prep your heart. Pray for a fresh outpouring upon yourself, your family, our parish, our nation, our world. We need it!

#### **OPENING PRAYER**

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of Your love.

- V. Send forth Your Spirit, and they shall be created,
- R. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray.

O God, Who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of Your faithful, grant that by that same Holy Spirit, we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolation, through Christ our Lord. Amen.
