## GOD'S LAST WILL & TESTAMENT

Please answer the following to ascertain what you took from the teaching:

4. As per Matthew 7:19-21, **every tree that does not bear good fruit must be torn down and thrown into the fire.** Please list all the Galatians 5 fruits / attributes of God that you do have – and how strong you are in them in the space below.
  
5. Now list the fruits of the Spirit you are weak in. Be sure to repent and ask God if there're any deep-seated reasons you struggle to bear these fruits and what you should do about it.
  
6. You're here because you were born again at some point. In looking back over the year(s) since your new birth, have you or have you not successfully left your old self behind? Is your old ID tucked away somewhere? Is he/she trying to maintain a place in your Christian life? If yes, you now know your old man has NO inheritance in Christ and cannot receive salvation. Please earnestly pray about this, repent, and ask Father why you refuse or struggle to surrender your whole self. Be real with Him so He can show you what's going on. He will help you come out of this and into complete commitment to Him.

Now that you understand that being saved requires believing and being baptized (purified and proved) which is a process that includes trials whereby you establish your faith, will you be more inclined to use the issues, challenges and obstacles of this life to prove your commitment to God by responding in love, peace, patience, joy, kindness, self-control, gentleness, faith (trust and confidence in God) and meekness?
