Free Smoke Alarms For Your Home!

Since October of 2014, the American Red Cross has been involved in a life saving campaign to reduce the number of deaths and injuries that are caused by home fires.

To accomplish that goal the Red Cross has partnered with local fire departments, churches, businesses and individuals to visit homes, check smoke alarms, replace nonworking smoke alarms, and educate people about home fire safety.

Our teams can come to your home. All you have to do is call the Southeastern Colorado Chapter at 719-785-2721. You can leave a message and a Red Cross representative will call you back to coordinate our response.

We can install up to 3 smoke alarms in your home, free of charge. We will check your current alarms, replace the battery or replace the entire unit. All of this at no cost to you.
