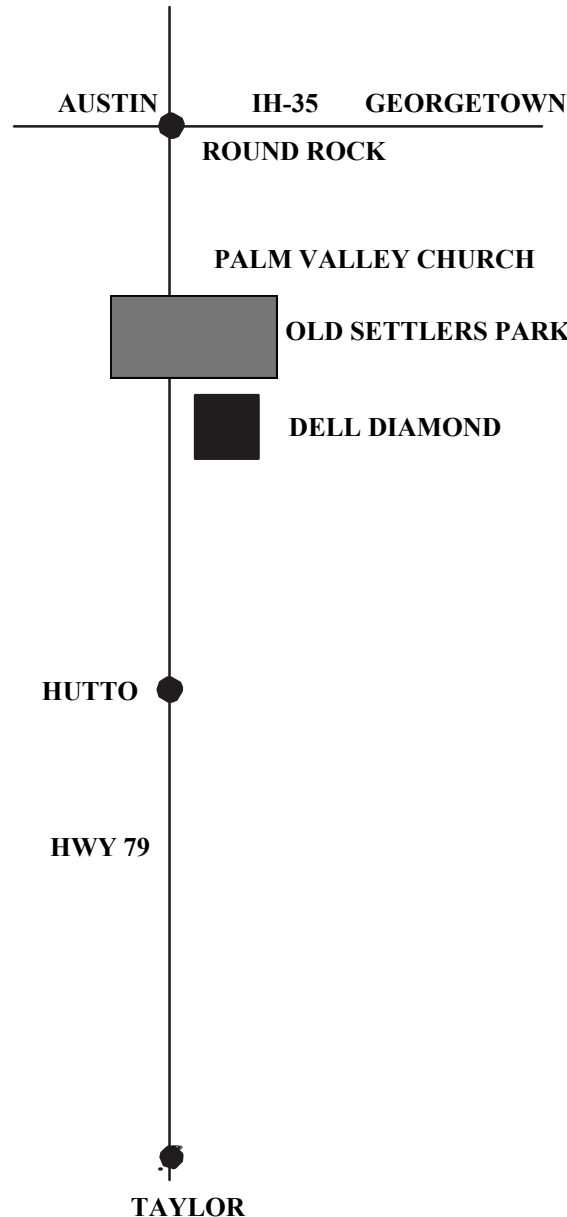

Paul is a fiddle player and vocalist from Taylor, who specializes in Texas Swing music. Not only does he play the fiddle but he has some exciting fiddle tricks for the audience.

Paul got his start in 1993 when he received his first fiddle, and at age 23 received his first fiddle lesson. He and Bill Dowdy began playing together

in 1997.

He was named the 2016 Western Swing song of the year by the Academy of Western Artists, one of the highest levels of recognition for western artists and entertainers of the world. He was also inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2012 and named it's Country and Swing Artist of the year 2014. He and his wife Tara were named Entertainers of the Year 2016.

He and his band have been performing for the Williamson County Old Settlers since 2006.
