Many new accomplishments occurred in the past year for the Fire Department. Early In 2015 the Township purchased a used Rescue truck, replacing a 1984 model. This purchase enabled us to consolidate all of our rescue equipment in one unit. It also allows us to refill our SCBA bottles here ,at the station. Previously we had to take them to town and have Sault F.D do it. The Rescue unit also has an onboard Generator and great scene lights for night time operations.

In June, the Fire Fighters Association hosted a fund raiser in conjunction with the community yard sale. Food , games and a 50/50 drawing were great, but he big draw seemed to be the dunk tank, featuring the Township Supervisor and the Fire Chief.

The Fire Department and its 21 members appreciate the township residences support on the millage voted on last fall. This will allow us to continue to improve our services for you.

All in all, it was a very good year. We responded to 21 calls during 2015. Several serious accidents and fires unfortunately occurred.

Thank you for supporting the Emergency Services Millage

Last August, the Board put a proposal on the ballot for a millage to cover the costs of providing emergency services for the Township. Voters supported the millage and it passed effective for the current fiscal year. This millage provides funding to ensure that the Township will continue to be able to contract ambulance service for the Township as well as help support the costs of the Dafter Township Volunteer Fire Department. The funds are first allocated to cover the cost of the ambulance contract that guarantees an ambulance will respond to calls in Dafter Township. Remaining funds will help offset the costs for the fire department and provide partial funding for much needed equipment upgrades.

Please remember that although you may have medical insurance that covers ambulance services, it does not guarantee that an ambulance will come to pick you up. The contract that Dafter Township has with Kinross EMS pays for having an ambulance on call if needed and guarantees that an ambulance will be dispatched when you call. Without this contract, ambulances are not required to respond to calls in the Township. The contract does not pay for your transport and medical treatment, it pays for the guarantee to get these services if needed. The medical services and treatment provided once the ambulance arrives is where your medical insurance provides coverage and will be billed.

The Dafter Township Board would like to thank the citizens for passing this important millage. You never know when you or a loved one may need emergency services and we are very happy that the voters decided to support this important service to the Township.
