

Fascinating A look at just what these three verses below say, 1300 hundred years before Islam. Written around 700 B.C., before Mohammed of Islam fame. Get your concordance or look one up online and check this out...

Isaiah 14:12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning!

[how] art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

I'm pointing out verse 14:12 here to support the following two verses are about the devil, Lucifer who was tossed from heaven.

Isaiah 14:13 For thou hast said in your heart, I will ascend [5927](#) into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

So the devil's ego has decided to go up to heaven and get his throne above the Lord's

Isaiah 14:14 I will ascend (same Hebrew word from the previous verse) above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

The devil's ego attempting to be 'like' the most high God the Father, and take HIS throne.

The point I am making here is found when we look closely at the Hebrew word translated 'ascend'. From the Strong's Concordance Hebrew section word # 5927. In simple terms the Hebrew word does mean to ascend, going up, to lift one's self up. In context, above the Lord.

THEN look closely at the Hebrew word translated 'Ascend' from Hebrew to English. It is pronounced in Hebrew... 'Alah'.

The Lord was warning us, (Israel) before the name allah was even considered by ole' mohammed or the Arabs as a name for their false God.
