Watchman Nee was holding a tent meeting in Outer Mongolia. After the meeting was over, an old man walked up to him and said, "When I was 14, my mother took me to a Buddhist temple to pray. "I looked at that idol and said to myself, 'Idol, you are just stone, and ugly, and you can't help anyone, so I'm not going to worship you.

Then I walked out in the courtyard and lifting my hands towards the sky, I said, "Oh God who made all this, I don't know who You are or anything about You, but it is You I am going to worship for the rest of my life.' "

Then with tears running down his face, the old man said, "I've met God twice in my life. Once was back in that courtyard, and now, this second time, when I know who He is."

So the question is this: When was the man saved? If as an old man, then how was he able to meet the Lord earlier, or if when he was 14, how could he have been saved without knowing the Gospel?

The answer is in Micah 6:8 and Romans 2:14-16
