General Notes

- 1. There will be other big events happening at Spire on both days. Parking will again be an issue especially on Saturday. **Please encourage your parents to carpool.**
- 2. Same entrance as last year for teams and spectators. East end of facility at the Swim meet Drop Off location. (See Map)
- 3. Registration for spectators will be on the second-floor level this year.
- 4. ONLY PIAA Officials and meet personnel will be allowed to use Door B-9.
- 5. All coaches and swimmers must get a hand stamp before they are allowed on the deck. No one will be allowed on the pool deck without the hand stamp. Swimmers are allowed on the deck 30 minutes before warm time. 12:30 on Friday and 11:30 on Saturday. Locker rooms will open at 12:15 and 11:15.
- 6. No shaving at Spire is allowed.
- 7. One coach from each team is to supervise their swimmers to make sure feet first entries are done during the warmups.
- 8. Team seating in the pool will be assigned again this year. This is based on last year's team locations. The assigned seating prevented dangerous rush for team seating that happened in the past. Also, there will be no need to get there extra early for preferred seating. A seating chart will be emailed out to all coaches. Teams will be required to sit in their assigned areas. Team names will be posted on the wall at their designated area.
- 9. All tickets for the will be sold online through Hometown Ticketing. **NO PAPER TICKETS**WILL BE SOLD AT THE GATE. Admission price is \$8.00 and tickets can be purchased by going to the website (https://www.piaadistrict10.org/d10-tickets). Search for the event in the list provided.
 - a. Friday-doors will be open for teams to enter the building at 12:00 PM. If teams arrive early, they can be admitted to cafeteria. (They may not be serving at that time) Spectators will be allowed in at 1:00 PM
 - b. Swimmers allowed in the locker rooms at 12:15 and on the deck 12:30 PM
 - c. Warm-ups begin at 1:00 PM for all teams.
 - d. Competition starts at 2:00 PM
- 10. Saturday doors will be opened for Teams to enter the building at 11:00 AM
 - a. Spectators will be allowed in at 12:00 PM.
 - b. Swimmers allowed in the locker rooms at 11:15 and on the deck 11:30 PM

- c. Warm-ups begin at 12:00 PM for all teams.
- d. Competition starts at 1:00 PM.

- 13. Day 2 Schedule AA Girls Boys followed by AAA Girls Boys by event
 - a. 100 Free, 500 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, (Awards for 100 Free, 500 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast), 400 yd Relay, (Awards 400 Relay, and AA Team Champions)
- 14. The meet will not be lived streamed.

 - **a.** I would appreciate it if you could send me names ahead of time and we will assign them lanes. My preference will be timers who can be there both days
