The following programs are available to students in grades 11-12: Animal & Plant Science, prerequisite – biology; Automotive Technologies; Biomedical Science & Technology; Building Construction Technologies; Careers in Education; Computer Science, prerequisite – algebra 1 with grade of “C” or better; Culinary Arts; Digital Media Arts; Health Science Technologies, prerequisite – biology; Marketing Technologies; Welding Technologies.
