Position Concept

Perform activities associated with the implementation of the company's gas leak program. Ensure that all activities are conducted to protect public safety, safeguard company assets and be in full compliance with Unitil's Operations & Maintenance procedural manuals. Respond as an emergency first responder to gas leak situations in a prompt and effective manner. Assess these situations and make recommendations and/or decisions that will ensure public safety. Perform scheduled gas surveys and analysis work on all company owned facilities. Perform activities associated with the maintenance, construction & inspection of the gas distribution system. Perform activities associated with the installation, maintenance and inspection of Company meter sets and other jurisdictional assets. Perform activities associated with the locating and mark-out of the gas distribution system, including activities associated with safe guarding company assets during third party excavations.

Qualifications

The successful candidate will have a High school diploma or equivalent and 3 years of related field experience. Must accept Company assigned service department standby on rotation basis. Must reside within the specified geographic call area and respond within 30 minutes (from home address) to gas leak emergencies, and be available for duties during times of system emergencies. Must be able to obtain Operator Qualification (O.Q.) certification based upon the requirements set forth in DOT 49 CFR 192, Subpart N. Must possess a valid Class A Commercial Driver's License within 24 months of employment.
