At ~10pm bread arrives and is sorted and boxed.

WHEN: Thursday, November 23
TIME: 8:00 a.m. until Delivered

On Thanksgiving morning, volunteer drivers line up in the bus loop to get maps, directions & boxes of food to deliver to each family's home.
Then, the work area is cleaned up.
