#### Things We Are Working On

We are in the process replacing the 3 common area fishing docks. We have approved bids to replace the docs and the contractor will start this spring and hopefully be finished before the end of the summer.

We have purchased the equipment to build a playground to be placed in the common area on the North side of the Sunrise Bridge. We are in the process of obtaining quotes for installation and hope to have the playground ready for use in the next few months.

#### Things To Consider

With mowing season upon us, we would like to remind you to please refrain from blowing cut grass into the street. The grass clogs the street drains and carries unnecessary solids and chemicals into the lake that affect the habitat, not to mention it is quite unsightly.

Just as important PLEASE DO NOT throw grass clippings into the lakes and drainage ditches. The ditches are not a dumping ground for yard waste.

Boats, trailers and campers are required to be parked on the side of homes or in back yards and on concrete pads. The garage is also acceptable if you have the space. When parked, these items are not to extend past the front of the dwelling. Short term parking in driveways for cleaning and use prep is acceptable. This is part of the Bill of Assurance, applies to all residents (member and non-member).

Please consider your neighbors when having get-togethers. Residents work and sleep at all sorts of hours. People have the right to have get-togethers but are expected to wrap it up by 10 PM., regardless of the day. Cabot nuisance laws apply to Magness Creek Village. The POA Board supports this.

Please remember that the speed limit is 25 mph in the neighborhood and that there are kids all over the place. Please slow down and ask your younger drivers to do the same.

#### **Animal Issues**

We have had a rash of missing animals that we helped find via Facebook. We don't mind sending out communications but please do try to control your animals; this isn't a full time job!

Loose dogs roaming the neighborhood are getting more prevalent, please make sure that your pets cannot get out of the backyard or off their leash. There are some pretty big dogs around here and may be cuddly at home but scared and defensive if they come across strangers. Please be a responsible owner. Animal control is more than willing to come out if needed.

#### Safe Route To School

The construction to Safe Route to School was finished last year and has created a nice new path between the north side and the school. There are quite a few parents and kids that use the path daily. We will ask you to please be aware that there are homes on either side of the path. Please stay out of their yards and do not litter.
