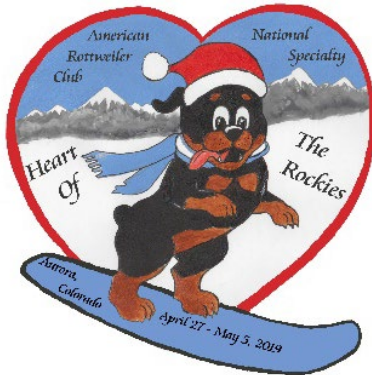

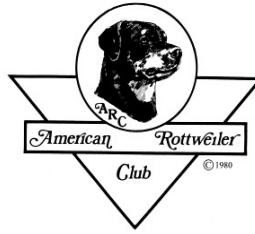

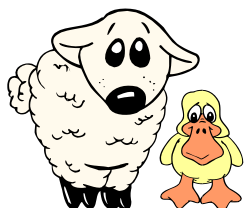

No RVs, trailers, or tents may camp at the trial site without site owner's permission. Please bring your own chairs. **Food truck will be available on site. There are fast food restaurants within 15 miles of the site.** Schedule will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class or test. **Please notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season.**

American Kennel Club Rules regarding Conduct will be strictly enforced.

A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH LEVEL MUST BE COMPLETED FOR EACH DOG ENTERED.

PLEASE FILL OUT EVERY FORM LEGIBLY AND COMPLETELY. There will be NO refunds for duplicate or errors on entry forms.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. No conditional or phone entries will be accepted. Entry forms will not be accepted without Fees or Signature. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to closing of entries.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the American Rottweiler Club, Twin Flame Farm, Mile High Rottweiler Club, and/or the Trial Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUND, AFTER CLOSING DATE, OF ANY DOG ACCEPTED IN THE TRIALS/TESTS IF NO ALTERNATE IS AVAILABLE. Refunds will be given to alternates unable to run.
