Thank you to all our members for your continued support. This fall our board of directors discussed a possible increase to our membership fee structure. Over the past few years we have seen a drastic increase in both the cost and requirements of our liability insurance. We currently pay just under \$5.00 per member for our liability insurance. Given this increased cost, the board proposed increasing the membership rates to \$20.00 for an adult membership and \$5.00 for a junior membership. We held a special meeting in October where the membership fees were approved to the proposed amounts. We are hopeful that this increase will ensure we can continue to provide our members with a safe, scenic place to practice your skills and socialize on your schedule.

Please remember to purchase your membership every year as memberships are required to utilize the range and participate in activities. Our club is funded exclusively through memberships and entry fees for our shoots. Without the funds from sales of memberships, it would be impossible for our club to continue to provide such a valuable community resource.
