## Hamblen County Car Club Minutes

July 18, 2017

The Hamblen County Car Club met Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at the Golden Corral with President Gene Honeycutt presiding. Twenty-seven people attended. He also led the group in an opening prayer.

Don McGinnis made a motion, seconded by David Sawyer to accept the June minutes as mailed. Motion carried.

Gene Honeycutt shared the financial reports for May and June. May revenue totaled \$1,129.00; expenses were \$1,249.56 with an ending balance of \$15,826.30. June income was \$203.00; expenses were \$82.67 which made the June bank balance \$15,946.63. This report was accepted after a motion by Ted Kalagian and a second by Guy Leolich.

**President's Remarks:** Gene Honeycutt reminded members of the upcoming ALP's Walk to Remember.

He said Dick Valentine and Guy Leolich will take charge of the Winter Angel Expo event. One night in August a drone will film the cruise-in for the Citizen Tribune's write-up about the Winter Angel Expo.

The Morristown Christmas parade theme this year will be "Christmas Memories." The club will be allowed to pay \$75.00 to enter 25 cars plus the trailer. This will be on December 3, 2017.

**Vice President's Remarks:** Guy Leolich encouraged members to actively recruit new members at the cruise-ins. We have been seeing new people with varied interests attending. If someone is interested in joining, there are membership applications available at the trailer.

**Fun Run Coordinator:** Theresa Blanken reminded members of the cook-out on Friday, July 21, at Don McGinnis' house. She said that Taco John's wants old cars to come out on Friday, August 4 from 5:00-9:00p.m. The lot is small, but the Lowe's parking lot can absorb the overflow.

**Trailer Ads:** Ted Kalagian said \$1,200.00 has been collected this year for trailer advertisements. Two previous ads have been cancelled. He is still waiting to hear from 3 others. Those sponsoring the Winter Expo are not charged for their ads. Ted asked if anyone would volunteer to work the trailer on Aug. 5. Sterling Lovin volunteered. Dick and Evie Valentine will also help. There are other dates where extra help would be appreciated.

**Winter Angel Car Show:** Guy Leolich said the event is almost already in the black. Anyone wanting to help will be welcomed. Next week, 5000 fliers will be ready to be distributed. Anyone attending other car shows should help to distribute these fliers.

**Old Business:** Gene said some members want to continue the traditional midnight shopping event for needy children at Christmas. If this continues, the suggestion is that the club will only sponsor 50 children with a limit of \$2,000.00. The Board of Directors will complete a budget which will probably include contributions of \$500 for each of the following charities: Alps, Food on Foot, Kingswood, and Serenity House.

**New Business:** Gene Honeycutt announced the Executive Committee would consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The Board of Directors will include the President, Vice President, Immediate Past President plus six members. For this year those members are Paul McClain, Ted Kalagian, Theresa Blanken, Evie Valentine, Marie Yount, and Don McGinnis. Gene also announced that the Board of Directors will also serve as the Finance committee along with the Treasurer. A budget will be completed to be submitted to the club.

The lucky winners of the free dinners from the Golden Corral were Elmer Blanken and Dick Valentine.

Don McGinnis made a motion to adjourn. Billy Seals offered the second. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned.

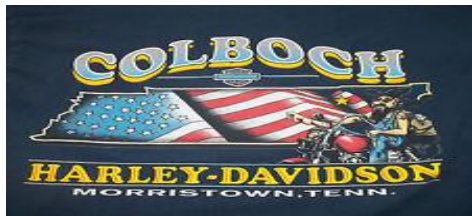
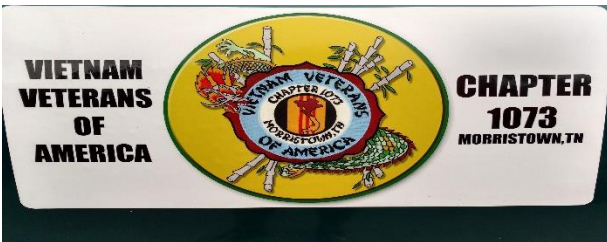

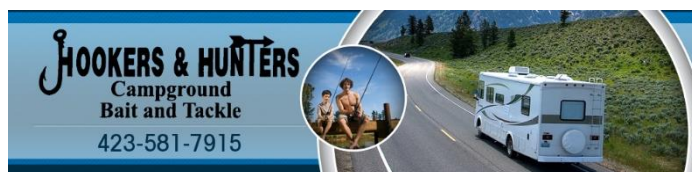
