March 20, 2018

The Hamblen County Car Club was called to order Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at the Golden Corral by President, Gene Honeycutt. Forty-one (41) members and two guests attended. Gene Honeycutt offered the opening prayer.

Guests: Lisa Grooms introduced an employee and a member of the board of directors from Serenity House. Both, Lora Murrrell and Katherine Coats spoke to the group about their involvement with this agency, which provides an end-of-life home for low or no-cost. In the past four years, they have provided a hospice home for 145 people. They also sponsor Camp Hugs, which is a grief camp for children.

February minutes were approved after a motion by Guy Leolich and a second by Ted Kalagian. A treasurers' report was not available.

President's Remarks: Gene reminded members that the *antique auto* tag is not for everyday use and law enforcement folks are stopping cars to check.

He also reminded members of several upcoming events: Benefit for Judy Smith at Community Baptist Church (4/7), Witt Baptist Church Car Show and Gospel Singing (4/7), No Way Jose's cruise in (4/20), Butch Grooms Memorial Car Show to benefit the Serenity House (4/21), and the Kingswood Show (5/19). He said the cruise-ins begin on April 7 from 5:00-8:00, at the same place as last year between Burger King and Health Star.

The new debit card has been issued with a \$500 limit.

William Bailey gave details of the Butch Grooms Memorial Car Show. This will be in the Price Less Foods' parking lot on Saturday, April 21. Registration is from 9-12:00; judging at 12:00; and several trophies will be awarded at 2:30.

Vice President's Remarks: Guy Leolich encouraged members to visit the Hamblen County Car Club website often. More use will move the site to the top of the list. He is still trying to eliminate the older sites. Guy is already working on the Winter Angel Expo for 2019. There will be dash plaques for the first 100 cars and no Swap Meet.

Events Coordinator: Jean Malott said the Poker Run has been postponed due to expected inclement weather on the scheduled date. She is working on a club bulletin board.

Trailer Ads: Ted Kalagian reported that he sent letters out to those who currently have ads on the trailer. He has collected around \$500 and will reach out with reminders at the end of the month to those who have not renewed.

Old Business: Mr. Honeycutt encouraged members to talk to cruise-in participates about membership. We need a volunteer to distribute the magazines. Paul McLain will take them to doctor offices and hospitals one more time.

There is money in the budget allocated to the Serenity House. Mr. Honeycutt would like to see a memorial bench bought and placed in their garden spot with the remainder of the allotment going directly to the agency for their use.

Member shirts may be purchased with the car club logo. These shirts can be embroidered in Pigeon Forge or by Kathy Wolfe (423-733-4450).

All members received an Easter treat (Thanks Deedra and Jean). Many door prizes were drawn. The Golden Corral free dinner tickets were won by Judy Hopkins and Marie Yount. Meeting adjourned after a motion by Don McGinnis, seconded by Larry Beede.
