## **Hamblen County Car Club Minutes**

**April 17, 2018**

The Hamblen County Car Club was called to order Tuesday, April 17, 2018 at the Golden Corral by President, Gene Honeycutt. Thirty-nine (39) members were in attendance. Gene Honeycutt led the group in prayer.

Don McGinnis made motion, seconded by David Sawyer to approve the March minutes as published. Motion carried. Janice Hawkins gave the treasurers' report. The end of March balance is \$17,927.20 with three current items to pay. This report was accepted with a motion by Wayne Musick and a second from Tony Hayes.

**President's Remarks:** Gene Honeycutt reminded members about upcoming events including the Butch Grooms Memorial car show and the show for Kingswood Home for children. He has checked prices on a memorial bench for Serenity House. The cost should be approximately \$150. The remainder of the \$500 allocation can be given directly to the Serenity House.

Gene stated that nominations for officers will take place at the May meeting with the election in June.

He also reported on shirts and hats. He thinks the club will order the shirts as well as 48 hats with half (24) of them having "member" embroidered on the back. The other 24 could be sold. Cost will be \$10 per hat, \$11 if embellished with the word "member."

Gene told members of the new inverter/battery that has been put on the trailer which will be much quieter than the old generator.

William Bailey showed members a set of Craftsman tools and said there is also an air compressor that has been donated to auction at the upcoming Butch Grooms Memorial car show.

After learning of the death of Robert Russell's sister, Mr. Honeycutt asked the club about a memorial donation. Mark Hughes made a motion, seconded by Tim Robinson, to donate \$100 to the Morristown Humane Society. Motion carried.

**Vice President's Remarks:** Guy Leolich said we had a fabulous turn-out for the first cruise-in with several cars from other counties. He has made the web site more mobile friendly. Old web sites and Facebook pages are mostly deleted now. He asked members to see Ted Kalagain about volunteering to keep the trailer during the cruise-ins.

**Events Coordinator:** Jean Malott said the Poker Run has been rescheduled for April 28. Everyone participating should be at Good Ole Days to register between 10:00 and 10:30. Members may eat there that day after the event for 50% off, excluding alcohol. They will also donate 20% of their May Monday night sales to the car club. Jean encouraged members to participate in a meet at Regency Retirement Center on May 11, 2018 from 5:30 to 7:30. There is also a *Picnic in the Park* scheduled for June 22, 2018 at Cherokee Park beginning at 3:00 pm.

**Trailer Ads:** Gene Honeycutt said there are only 3-4 spots left on the trailer for new ads.

**Other:** Members were reminded to get an application on any new member. There is a member list in the trailer. Panhandlers at the cruise-ins were discussed. There is a community event on June 23 – a school bus will be parked somewhere close to Merchants Green hoping to be filled with donated school supplies. The Witt car show has been rescheduled for June 2, 2018.

No additional old business or new business was introduced. Lucky winners for the Golden Corral dinners were Gwen Hughes and Don McGinnis. Meeting adjourned.

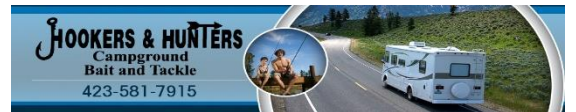
