

#### Dear church family,

Even though Advent does not officially start until December 3rd, I have already started our Advent sermon series- "The Women of Jesus' Family Tree." This is not your traditional Advent study where we focus on love, hope, joy, and peace. Instead, we are looking at 5 women who somehow got listed on Jesus' family tree despite being women in a maledominated society. On top of it, some, if not all of these women have a sketchy past. At the close of November, we have already discussed Tamar and her deception in getting children. We still have to talk about the prostitute Rahab, the foreigner Ruth, the adulteress/rape victim Bathsheba, and Mary the mother of Jesus. Yes, Mary is questionable. You may believe in a virgin birth, but how do you think her family and neighbors saw this pregnancy. It was very questionable in their minds. Yet the gospel writer Matthew specifically identifies these 5 women. He did not just randomly throw in their names. There was a purpose. Join me in delving into their stories, learn from them, and then be changed by their stories.

Every life is a testimony. Do you desire to hear and be changed? I hope so. Hope to see you at worship with us.



# MITTEN TREE AND SOCK BOX

Traditionally each year we set up a tree for individuals to \* contribute mittens, gloves, scarfs, and caps. These items are displayed on the tree as ornaments. They are socks and underwear. Therefore, beside our "mitten tree," you will find a brightly decorated "sock box" for you to donate too as \* well.

### **Riverdale ABC Project**

The Riverdale Middle School students are looking for help from the public. The students are collecting hard plastic caps for the ABC Project. This project is designed by school children, for school children, to encourage caring for the earth. ABC stands for "A Bench for Caps." They are hoping to reach a goal of 400-800 lbs. of plastic lids. After the first 400, they are eligible to receive a bench which will be placed wherever the students want on the school grounds. All are asked to help. We will have a collection box at the base of our church ramp for your donations. Some of the acceptable lids and caps are: medicine caps, milk jug caps, detergent caps, hair spray caps, flip top caps, spout caps, spay paint caps, ointment caps, cottage cheese lids, yogurt lids, peanut butter lids, cool whip container lids, coffee can lids, and butter container lids to name a few.
