Epping Art Association Pop up Show Prospectus

This is the prospectus for the Epping Art Association(EAA) pop-up show scheduled for August 19. This document will inform all participants of the conditions of this event. The show will take place on the first floor of the Epping Recreation Center from 10 am to 3 pm. (set up the night before)

This art exhibition will be a one day event. Paintings will be hung on Friday night and taken down immediately following the show. We ask that all artwork remain on the wall for the duration of the event. There is no theme and no time restriction for when the work was completed.

The EAA reserves the right to exclude any artwork that may be deemed offensive or inappropriate.

- Tables will be available for \$15.00 for those who have small items for sale.

Fees:

Artists may hang work in this show at no charge. However The EAA will collect 20% of all sales. All money collected from sales of artwork and table fees will be given to the **End 68 hours of Hunger** program of the town of Epping. The other 80% of all sales will belong to the artists.

Participants:

Participants are members of the EAA, and/or artists that have been invited by a member of the EAA. Participation is by invitation only due to space restrictions.

Requirements:

Artists may submit up to four piece for hanging. All pieces must be framed and wired to hang, OR work can be back-stapled canvas (edges must be painted)

Requirement List

- The maximum size is 12 x 16 due to space restrictions.
- Artwork may be marked NFS (Not For Sale)
- All Bin artwork must be matted if it is to be hung in the central bin area.
- Artists may have their own bin and work in these bins can be sold at the discretion of the artist.
- Bin prices should reflect a discount.
- All artists are responsible for their own transactions.
- Artists are expected to be at the show for its duration. (5 hrs)
- No artwork can be stored at the Epping Rec Center and must be removed after the show.(3pm)
- There will be no food sold at this event. Bottled water will be available and be counted for the charity.

Advertising for this event will begin the week of July 10th. All local papers and social media outlets will be contacted and all artists are encouraged to promote this by word of mouth and social media.

The Names of participating artists will not be disclosed through these outlets.
