The theme for this year's Education Sunday is, "Catholic Schools: serving the common good". Pope Francis said recently that education should "train young people to be open and interested in the reality that surrounds them, capable of care and tenderness, free from the widespread prejudice where you must be competitive, aggressive, and hard towards others, especially towards those who are different, foreign or in any way seen as an obstacle to one's own affirmation". Catholic schools in Scotland are putting into action these words of Pope Francis by being inclusive communities which welcome, value, affirm and support all pupils, parents and staff to fulfil the potential of their God-given talents. In this historic year, we mark the centenary of the Education Act that saw Catholic schools come under state governance.

Reflection:

"Ideally words should always be preceded by deeds. When people who have done something begin to speak, people listen. Their words carry enormous weight. They have real authority. The weakness of a lot of words arises from the fact that they are not preceded, or accompanied, or even followed by deeds. At the root of innumerable wrongs in our world is the discrepancy between word and deed. It is the weakness of Churches, parties and individuals. It gives people and institutions split personalities.
