Getting there:

Please check with the relevant service providers for up-to-the minute information.

INTERNATIONAL:

Eurostar

Eurostar services from Europe terminate at St Pancras International station. Catch the tube from Kings Cross St Pancras tube station to The O2. It's just a 25minute trip.

All London airports are well connected to The O2 via tube and rail services. Plan your journey at TfL.gov.uk.

Flying into Stanstead? Book your Stanstead Express tickets with the O2 partner Greater Anglia [https://www.greateranglia.co.uk].

Use London City Airport or Biggin Hill for your private aircraft.

TUBE & TRAIN:

North Greenwich station is on the Jubilee Line (Grey line) in Zones 2 and 3. And it's right on our doorstep.

Uber AND PRIVATE HIRE:

Drop-off and pick-up:

The Uber and private hire pickup area for pre-booked rides is next to Car Park 3 (just past Tesco) and is staffed by experienced taxi marshals on event nights. Please check availability on the day

Get a safe, reliable ride with a licensed partner-driver with the Uber app to and from The O2. It only takes a few taps to request your ride, and a partner-driver will be with you within just a few minutes. Please remember that booking private hire guarantees that a licensed driver in a licensed vehicle will carry out your trip.

BLACK TAXI RANK

Grab a ride home in an iconic London Black Taxi, voted the world's best taxi service. All taxis are wheelchair accessible and accept credit cards.

North Greenwich station taxi rank is on your left as you exit the station towards The O2 and operates 24 hours a day, every day.

Taxi Marshals

Our marshals are former taxi drivers who are there to help you get a taxi home. They manage passenger queues and on event nights they connect to thousands of taxi drivers in the local area.

BUS:

Jump on the 108, 129, 132, 161, 188, 422, 472 or 486. They all stop at North Greenwich station.


Visitors can get the 188 bus (24 hour) direct to/from central London via Waterloo. Remember that you can no longer pay with cash on buses. Get more info here:

The Night Buses:

The 188, 108 and 472 run 24hrs a day, 7 days a week. On Friday and Saturday nights the 132 and 486 also run through the night to coincide with the night tube. However, the 188 is the only night bus that connects to central London, travelling via Waterloo.



RIVER BUS:

Arrive at The O2 for your concert in comfort and style with the MBNA Thames Clippers River Bus Express. Travel from London Eye or London Bridge piers in just 35 minutes, enjoying spectacular views of the capital and licensed on-board bars. Upgrade to VIP tickets to include a chilled glass of Champagne.

Avoid the queues on your journey home. After Show services depart 15-20 minutes after showdown. Copy and paste the link into your browser for more details https://www.thamesclippers.com/going-to-the-o2.

In addition to the River Bus Express, MBNA Thames Clippers call at North Greenwich Pier for The O2 every 20 minutes throughout the day. Whatever you're doing in London, whether it's commuting, sightseeing, or simply going from A to B, MBNA Thames Clippers covers all your needs with Single, Return or hop-on, hop-off all day River Roamer ticketing options.

COACH:

There's free parking for coaches at the O2 when you pre-book Daily River Roamer, Single or Return tickets on MBNA Thames Clippers. You could schedule for a whole day's event to finish it off with the Party on the boat.

CYCLING:

The O2 is on lots of cycle routes. There are 500 cycle racks in Car Parks 2, 3 and 4 and by North Greenwich station.



Please be aware that bicycles are not permitted to travel through the Blackwall Tunnel. Please plan an alternative route if you're cycling from the north of the river.

By tube:

Only folding bicycles are permitted on the Jubilee line through North Greenwich station. By cable car:

Bicycles are permitted on the Emirates Air Line cable car at all times.

Bv rail:

Please check whether bicycles are permitted on your route with your train operator before travelling.

DRIVING THERE:

It is inside the M25 and outside the Congestion Zone. The O2 is signposted from the M25, the A2 and A20 (from the South East), and the M11 (from the North).



ACCESSIBILITY:



Getting to The O2

The O2 is a large site. You'll need to cover a fair distance from North Greenwich Station and the car parks. Contact us before your event if you need help.



Tube and bus

Accessible features at North Greenwich station:

- low-level ticket machines and a gate to the right of the ticket barriers for wheelchair access
- an induction loop
- · step-free access to all platforms with lifts
- step-free bus stops
- accessible toilets
- · assistance dogs are welcome

MBNA Thames Clippers

Boats

All of the boats are wheelchair and pram accessible by ramp. There's a limit of four wheelchairs on the larger boats, but they can accommodate a further three folding wheelchairs. Electronic wheelchairs are also welcome. Members of the Thames Clippers Mobility Scooter Recognition Scheme are able to bring their mobility scooters on board.

Facilities

All boats except the Star, Storm and Sky Clippers have accessible toilets and larger boats have baby changing tables. Their size and door dimensions are:

Sun and Moon clippers

1510mm (wall with door) x 1650mm

Door width 860mm

Typhoon Class

1560mm (wall with door) x 1710mm

Door width 890mm

Piers

All piers are wheelchair accessible except London Bridge, Wandsworth Riverside Quarter, Putney and Cadogan piers. Ramps are used for boarding.

MBNA Thames Clippers Mobility Scooter Recognition Scheme

If you'd like to bring your mobility scooter on board Thames Clippers you can contact the customer services team to make an appointment to check that your scooter is suited to travel.

Guide and assistance dogs

You can bring a Guide or Assistance dog on board with you without charge. Thames Clippers welcome all Guide and Assistance dogs, including:

- Fetch and carry dogs
- · Mental health companion dogs
- Seizure-alert dogs

Please remember that Guide or Assistance dogs aren't allowed on seats.

Audio and visual information

All of the boats have audible 'next stop' announcements on board. And the piers have visual 'next boat' information.

Assistance

Thames Clippers crews on board the boats and staff at the piers are more than happy to offer help and assistance.

In case you missed it, here are the parking charges again:

Parking is charged at hourly rates in Car Parks 2, 3 and 4. For Cineworld, it is four hours' free parking in Car Parks 2 and 3. Your four hours start once you're in the car park. When the film's finished, take your unpaid ticket and cinema stub to the parking office (opposite Car Park 2).

Look out for a steward if you need help while you're in the car park. Or use the intercom system at the car park entrance. The parking office is open 24 hours a day and is at the top of Car Park 1.
