The Holy Spirit in Relation to Man in the Old Testament

- I. Selective Indwelling
 - a. Spirit said to be 'within' these:
 - i. Joseph – Gen 41:38
 - ii. Joshua – Numbers 27:18
 - iii. Daniel – Daniel 4:8, 5:11-14
 - b. Spirit said to be 'upon' these:
 - i. Judges 3:10, 6:34, 11:29, 13:25
 - c. Spirit said to have 'filled' some:
 - i. Exodus 31:3, 35:31 – for service
- II. Role of restraining man from Sin
 - a. Genesis 6:3
 - b. Neh. 9:20
 - c. Ps 51:11
- III. Role of Enabling Man for Service – Exodus 31 (again)
- IV. Limitations
 - a. Limited in extent (not all)
 - b. Limited in Duration (not for lifetime)

Holy Spirit – In relation to Jesus Christ

- I. The Birth of Christ
 - a. The agent of the virgin birth (Luke 1:35)
 - b. The result of the virgin birth
- II. The Life of Christ
 - a. Christ was anointed by the Spirit (Luke 4:18, Acts 4:27)
 - i. The anointing distinguished Him as the Messiah
 - ii. The anointing empowered Jesus for His ministry (Luke 4:18)
 - iii. Anointing connected to doing good (Acts 10:38)
 - b. Christ was filled with the Spirit (Luke 4:1, John 3:34, Isa. 11:2)
 - c. Christ was sealed with the Spirit (John 6:27)
 - d. Christ was led by the Spirit (Luke 4:1)
 - e. Christ rejoiced in the Spirit (Luke 10:21)
 - f. Christ was empowered by the Spirit (Matt 12:28)

- I. Persons who are indwelt – Christians (I Cor. 3:16, 6:19)
 - a. Sinning Christians also possess the Spirit
 - b. Holy Spirit is a gift (John 7:37-39, Romans 5:5)
 - c. Absence of Holy Spirit is sign of Unsaved condition (Romans 8:9)
