Ezekiel 22:28

- Job 1:22 “In all this Job sinned not nor charged God foolishly”
 - I. Care in attributing words and actions to the Almighty
 - a. Prophets in Ezekiel lied about God speaking
 - b. Job did not charge God with the ruin of his life
 - c. We must caution ourselves against “God told me...”
 - d. We must caution ourselves against “Well, God did this to me”
 - II. Moses reaction to God’s command – Numbers 16
 - a. The sin of the people
 - b. God’s anger against their sin
 - c. God’s command for Moses and Aaron to get out
 - d. Moses response and Aaron’s actions

III. Moses knew God

- a. There was a burning bush (Ex 3)
- b. There was an interaction with Pharaoh (Ex 7-12)
- c. There was a Red Sea crossing (Ex 14)
- d. There was a mountain top experience (Ex 20)
- e. There was water from the rock (Ex 17)
- f. There was manna from heaven (Ex 16)
- g. All of this -BEFORE- Moses dared to “know”
