- I. Biblical example: Asa II Chron. 14:2-7, 16:7-13
- II. Humility is God's desire of us – Is. 57:15
- III. We need a proper perspective of God – Is. 6:1-7
- IV. We need a proper perspective of us – Luke 18:13
- V. Some characteristics of the Humble:
 - a. Overwhelmed with their spiritual need
 - b. They forgive much
 - c. Compassionate
 - d. Willing to yield their rights
 - e. Will promote others
 - f. Not concerned about self
 - g. Transparent
 - h. Quick to admit when they are wrong

Obedience – Matthew 7:24-27

- I. God expects obedience – Exodus 40
- II. God's commands are for our benefit
- III. God's commands are easy to obey
- IV. God wants FULL obedience – I Sam. 15:22-23
- V. Questions concerning obedience:
 - a. Is there anything God wants me to do that I have not done yet?
 - b. Have I placed limits on what I will do for God?

- c. Am I continuing to do something God wants me to stop?
- d. How would I feel if I knew Jesus was coming back today?

Grace – Psalm 86:1-7

- I. Saving grace – Ephesians 2:1-9
- II. Sanctifying grace –
 - a. In temptation (I Cor. 10:13)
 - b. Help from the throne (Heb. 4:15-18)
 - c. Our position (Romans 6:14)
 - d. Our response (Romans 6:1-2)
- III. Suffering grace – II Cor. 12:8-9)
- IV. Where do you need grace?
 - a. Dealing with major disappointment
 - b. Needing to forgive someone
 - c. To mend a broken relationship
 - d. Dealing with loneliness
 - e. Dealing with my past
 - f. To bear chronic pain
 - g. Overcoming besetting sin
 - h. To break a bad habit

Honesty –

- I. Biblical example: David Psalm 32
- II. God is Light – I John 1:5-9
 - a. In Him – no darkness
 - b. Not to be living contrary to that Light (vs. 6)
 - c. Fellowship from walking in the Light
 - d. We only deceive ourselves
- III. The concealing of sin (Mark 9:33-34)
 - a. Adam and Eve (Gen. 3:8-9)
 - b. We are accountable (Luke 12:2)
- IV. Questions concerning Honesty:
 - a. Am I being hypocritical in any area? (James 1:22)
 - b. Do I ignore the conviction of God?
 - c. Do I think more highly of myself than what God knows of me? (Gal. 6:3)
 - d. Am I covering sins of the past
