 - b. Grace & Peace – vs. 2
 - c. Life and Godliness – vs. 3
 - d. Divine nature – vs. 4

- II. The great qualities and virtues (5-15)
 - Virtue, knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, kindness, love

- III. The results of adding these
 - a. Keep you from being barren
 - i. How barren?
 - 1. Not – fruitful
 - 2. Not Spirit filled
 - b. Keep you from being blind
 - i. Blind to self
 - ii. Blind to sin
 - iii. Lack of discernment
 - c. Remind you that you were cleansed
 - d. Keep you from falling
 - i. Falling into Sin
 - ii. Fall for false teaching

 - b. Inspiration of Scripture -verse 21

 - a. Have always been around (verse 1)
 - b. Teach destructive heresies

- c. Mislead people (verse 2)
 - d. Shall be judged (verse 3)
 - e. Example of Angels and Lot

 - b. Be mindful
 - c. The Scoffers – vs 3
 - i. Questioning
 - ii. Willingly ignorant – vs 5
 1. Creation
 2. Noah's flood
 3. Continue because of God
- II. Jesus is coming again – vs. 8-10
 - a. God's measure of time – vs 8
 - b. God is true to His promise – vs 9
 - c. His coming will be sudden – vs 10
- III. Our responsibility due to His return – vs. 11-14
 - a. Live Holy – vs 11
 - b. Look for His return – vs 12
