"Eli Elder must try and save his town, after an evil ranchers family decide to take it over."


Niche Audiences







DIRECTOR/WRITER Jack Snyder



<u>Jack Snyder</u> is a prolific award-winning screenwriter with eight produced feature-length screenplays under his belt, three of which he directed. His films have been distributed by 20th Century Fox, NBCUniversal, Warner Brothers, and Sony. Several have shown theatrically, and aired on The Showtime Network, The Movie Channel, the Syfy Channel, and the Lifetime Movie Network.

Jack got his start in filmmaking by writing and directing the thriller, <u>Ghost Image</u>, starring Elizabeth Rohm (American Hustle, Joy), and Stacey Dash (Clueless). The film won multiple awards and was distributed worldwide. His second film, a crime drama titled <u>Fatal Call</u>, starring Jason London (Dazed and Confused, The Man in the Moon), Danielle Harris (Halloween 4 and 5), Kevin Sorbo (Hercules: The Legendary Journeys), and Lochlyn Munro (Unforgiven, Riverdale) can be viewed on Amazon as well as other online streaming services. The third film he wrote and directed, titled <u>Family of Lies</u>, stars John Schneider (The Dukes of Hazzard, Smallville), Christa B. Allen (13 Going on 30, Ghosts of Girlfriends Past), and Peyton Wich (Stranger Things, Goosebumps 2: Haunted Halloween). The film airs regular on the Lifetime Movie Network and available on DVD through Sony.

In addition to writing his own original scripts, Jack has done many screenplay adaptations of novels. He had the honor of being chosen to adapt the best-selling horror novel, *Cold Moon Over Babylon*, written by the late Michael McDowell, a novelist and screenwriter most famous for Beetlejuice and The Nightmare Before Christmas. The Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, the organization that gives out the Oscars, requested a copy of Jack's screenplay for its Core Collection. The screenplays in this collection are used for research and study purposes by producers, academics, and students. The film produced from the screenplay, titled <u>Cold Moon</u>, stars Josh Stewart (The Dark Knight Rises), Candy Clark (American Graffiti, Twin Peaks), Frank Whaley (Ray Donovan, Luke Cage), and Christopher Lloyd (Back to The Future). The film was released theatrically and is currently available on DVD, Blu-ray, and many online streaming services.

Though several of Jack's screenplays would fall under the thriller category, he's written in every genre, such as historical dramas, comedies, science fiction, western, and faith-based.

His many other produced films have starred such celebrities as Florence Henderson (The Brady Bunch), Pam Grier (Jackie Brown, Mars Attacks), Judge Reinhold (Beverly Hills Cop, The Santa Clause), and Kristy Swanson (Ferris Bueller's Day Off, Buffy the Vampire Slayer).

When Jack is not writing or directing movies, he and his wife hike the many canyons in the San Fernando Valley are hang out with their two Chihuahuas on Zuma Beach in Malibu.

The Oklahoma Film Rebate Program

The Oklahoma Film Enhancement Rebate Program offers a cash rebate of 35-37% on qualifying Oklahoma expenditures to film and television productions filming in the state. The rebate is extended to film, television and commercial productions.

The rebate currently has a \$4 million rolling cap per fiscal year (July 1-June 30) and has been renewed through 2024. There is no per-project cap, but each production must have a minimum budget of \$50,000 and spend \$25,000 in qualified Oklahoma spend. Rebate funds are pre-qualified for eligible applicants on a first-come, first-served basis.

The rebate offers a base percentage of 35% on qualified Oklahoma expenditures. If a minimum of \$20,000 is spent on music that has been recorded in Oklahoma by an Oklahoman or on Oklahoma music production costs, an additional 2% is added to the total rebate on qualified Oklahoma expenditures, for a total of 37%. Filming in Tombstone, AZ

Qualified productions can earn transferable tax credits and tax exemptions for producing their projects (films, television programs, video games, photo-shoots, etc.) in Arizona. Pre-approved projects can transferable tax credits based on Arizona expenditures in the following amounts: \$250,000-\$1,000,000: Eligible for a 20% transferable tax credit. More than \$1,000,000: Eligible for a 30% transferable tax credit.

The Tax Credits may be used to offset AZ tax liability, sold, or transferred. Unused tax credit amounts may be carried forward for up to five years. Productions can also receive Transaction Privilege Tax and Use Tax exemptions for AZ expenditures totaling \$250,000 and up.

Build a studio or construct another eligible infrastructure project in Arizona and qualify for transferable tax credits equal to 15% of the eligible AZ project costs! Some of the requirements include: The facility must be owned and operated by the applicant. The applicant agrees to submit a report to the Arizona Dept of Commerce upon completion of the project, and Arizona project expenditures for a soundstage are at least: \$250,000 within 90 days of pre-approval An additional \$1,000,000 within 12 months of pre-approval A total of \$5,000,000 within 36 months of pre-approval

Arizona project expenditures for a support and augmentation facility are at least: \$250,000 within 90 days of pre-approval A total of \$1,000,000 within 36 months of pre-approval

The Tax Credits generated by infrastructure projects may be used to offset AZ tax liability, or they may be sold, or transferred. Unused tax credit amounts may be carried forward for up to five years.

The Reel Savings program provides discounts and rebates from participating Reel Savings businesses ("Vendors") to participating Reel Savings entertainment industry professionals ("Users") doing business in the State of Arizona.

By agreeing to participate in the program, either as a User, Vendor or both ("Participants"), you and/or your company agree to the following terms and conditions of the Reel Savings program, in addition to the <u>Privacy Policy</u> and <u>Site</u> <u>Terms and Conditions</u> that govern registration and use of the <u>www.GoFilmAZ.com</u> (<u>www.azcommerce/film-media</u>) website.



PARTICIPATION: All Participants MUST be approved by the Film Office.

Participating Reel Savings Users and Vendors must be located within the State of Arizona and/or doing business in Arizona at the time Reel Savings discount/rebate(s) are received or provided.

Qualifying Vendors are approved vendors who are registered with Film Office and provide an industryrelated product or service listed within the Film Office's Support Services AND are able to provide a **minimum** discount/rebate of 10% to participating Users. <u>Register your business here.</u>

Qualifying Users are approved individuals and businesses registered with the Film Office Crew Directory and/or Support Services Directory. *If you are with an Out-of-State industry executive/manager with a production company or studio, you must have an approved, registered film/digital media project with the Film Office to qualify. <u>Register your project here</u>.
