If everything is perfectly constructed, and the finishing process uses the wrong equipment, is hurriedly or carelessly completed, all the good work done up to this point is wasted. Finishing does not mean polishing everything to perfection! Sometimes large machines and too much polishing erases touches designed to give the project its natural, unique feel. By being on-site, Tony informs the builder what equipment not to use, and when to stop polishing. 


