

BELLE MEADE TERRACE CONDOMINIUMS POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Due to the guidelines established by the Tennessee Health Department, the Board of Directors of Belle Meade Terrace Homeowners' Association has adopted the following Rules and Regulations for POOL USE during the season.

1. Pool hours will be from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. daily.
2. Pool access can be made either through the wooden gate or the sliding door in the pool house, but only when the pool is permitted and legally open.
When you leave the pool area please see that the sliding door is closed.
3. Cut off shorts or pants will not be allowed – loose pieces of string will clog the filter system, resulting in the pool being closed until repairs are made.
4. NO PETS of any kind will be allowed inside the pool fence areas, (Dogs or Cats)
5. No glass of any kind will be allowed inside the pool fence area, including trash receptacles. Do not bring glass into the pool area or dispose of it inside the clubhouse.
6. No one under the age of 14 will be allowed to use the pool without adult supervision – NO EXCEPTIONS.
7. No running, diving or horseplay allowed in the pool area.
8. Volleyball net and posts must be removed immediately after usage and stored in a proper place away from the pool area.
9. The GATE must be CLOSED and LOCKED at all times. Do not brace open. This is for your protection as well as to keep uninvited guests out.
10. All guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times.
11. The swimming pool area is part of the common areas owned by the homeowners and is RESTRICTED TO OWNERS, ACCOMPANIED GUESTS AND RESIDENTS and has been assigned the privilege by the unit owner with Board approval. Homeowners should limit the number of guests to four (4) per household, per visit.
12. HOMEOWNERS AND RESIDENTS MAY NOT LOAN POOL KEYS to anyone. Only one key per unit is issued. Pool privileges may be revoked for rule infractions.

Strict adherence to these rules will ensure efficient operation of the pool. Failure to follow these rules could result in a lost right to use the pool and major violations could result in the closing of the pool by Metro Health Department for the entire season. Your cooperation is required and will be appreciated.
