



Legal Advice Clinics

Houston Volunteer Lawyers is a non-profit that provides free legal services to low-income residents of Harris County by connecting them with volunteer lawyers who agree to handle their case for free. Each year, Houston Volunteer Lawyers assists more than 10,000 people in need of critical legal assistance.

Types of Cases accepted:

- Family Law (Divorce and Custody)
- Landlord/Tenant/Home Ownership
- IRS Tax Disputes
- Wills and Probate
- Consumer Law

Not accepted: criminal, traffic, or fee-generating cases.

Legal advice clinics are held on the first and third Saturday of every month at various locations. The clinic starts at 8 am and we assist until capacity met. The clinics are open to anyone needing legal advice.

At the legal advice clinics, applicants meet with a licensed Texas attorney one-on-one and receive free advice on their legal issue. Individuals needing continued representation beyond the legal advice clinic must be residents of Harris County and have a household income of no greater than 200% of federal poverty guidelines.
