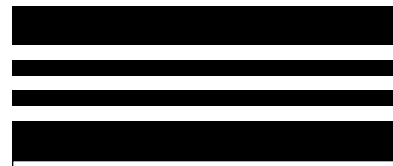

- Late renewal – **\$90** (not required when renewing with a transfer/rehire application)
- Certified trainer endorsement renewal – **\$15** (in addition to the renewal fee)

Fingerprinting

All security guards must have fingerprint-based background checks. For information about the fingerprinting and background check process, go to www.dol.wa.gov/business/fingerprinting.html.

Armed applicants

- Be at least 21 years old and be licensed as an unarmed security guard.
- Submit a completed security guard license application and pay the \$10 armed endorsement fee.
- Have a current firearms certificate. To be an armed security guard you must attend an eight-hour firearms certification course certified by the Criminal Justice Training Commission, telephone (206) 835-7300. When you complete the firearms training, they will issue a certificate. We cannot issue you an armed license until we receive your firearms certificate. RCW 18.170.040(c)
- Alien residents need to submit proof of an alien firearm license. Visit dol.wa.gov for information on how to get your alien firearms license.

Armed renewal

By renewing the armed private security guard license with the Department, the principal partner or principal owner for the private security guard company is declaring that the armed security guard has met the requirements for annual proficiency with the firearms for which he/she is certified.
