- Elevation-below 5000 ft
- Terrain- ditches, ravines, streams, riverbanks and washed in desert areas
- Water use- low
- Symbiotic relationships- the seeds are eaten by wildlife, flowers attract hummingbirds, it provides a nesting site for desert birds and ground cover for other animals.
- Edible?- no?
- Values- flowers are used to treat coughs and bronchial problems. It has also been used to treat fungal infections. Bows and baskets made by indigenous people. It's a good honey plant.
