- Elevation- 2500 feet
- Terrain- rocky dry slopes of desert mountains
- Water use- very low
- Symbiotic relationships- the fruits are eaten by many insects, small mammals and birds
- Values (medicinal, any other human uses)- according to the cahuilla Indians, the red sap was used as a panacea, used the sap to treat skin disorders and other diseases
