

## **Calliandra eriophylla:**

“Fairy duster”

### **Description:**

- Fairy dusters are small evergreen shrubs and retain foliage for much of the year. Height and width varies from 1 to 5 feet. The furry blooms are generally white, cream and pink.
- Requires a bit of routine pruning, since it grows outwards and has lots of blossoms, but only in spring.

### **Uses:**

- The fairy duster will attract wildlife, such as birds, bees and insects which are great pollinators.

### **Management:**

- Best thriving in full sun with an moderate watering until established. After the watering, it would be able to survive with in times of drought, Soil has to be well drained.
