Effective **July 1st, 2017**, in accordance with Millbrook By-Laws and Rules and Regulations, any member's account more than **30** days past due will be charged a **\$20** late fee plus **1.5%** interest per month until the members account is current. Also in accordance with Millbrook's By-Laws, members who are habitually delinquent will be required to pay their account by bank draft.
