We will begin to lower the height throughout the upcoming months as the greens fill in and become healthier. We are rebuilding the pump system in our sprayer and will begin spraying the weeds in the fairways and green surrounds as soon as possible. When using carts, drop off one player and proceed to the next ball.

ON THE GREEN

Please repair your ball mark and one other.

Player whose ball is closest to the pin should tend the flag.

Look over your putt while others are putting.

Be ready to putt when its your turn.

The first player to finish should be ready to replace the flag.

Leave the green immediately and make your score on the next tee.
