Millbrook Board of Directors and Staff have been working very hard to pay our bills and have a good product on the course. I believe the course is getting better. I know we are spending the funds we have as wisely as possible. I have to admit it's been tough and could get even tougher. Our membership is low. We currently have 133 members and 43 social members. The local golf and swim teams have paid fees to use our facilities. We have collected most of our delinquent accounts.

Taxes are due every year and again we're under the gun to pay them. We are grateful to the Ladybugs for making a \$1,619 payment toward our tax bill but that still leaves us with a balance due of approximately \$15000.00. We are planning on using the money from the school swim teams and the annual July charges to help pay down the taxes and this may be enough to pay them off this year, but we still have a very tight money problem.

The Board of Directors has voted to renew our Drawdown event. In the past, we have raised over \$20,000 at this event. The event will be held in November. The cost of the ticket is \$100. Each ticket includes a nice dinner for two, a chance to win at the drawdown event and a dance afterwards. The Drawdown has always been a fun event, a chance for members and guests to come together, have a good time and support our club. We're asking each member to purchase a ticket and come to the event or sell the ticket, you can even go in with someone else as a partner. The club will add the \$100 to your monthly bill in August and you can come by and pick up the ticket at the Pro Shop. **If you have a hardship and cannot participate and help our club anymore than you already do, we understand. We do not want to lose any members over this, we ask that you put it in writing if you are unable to purchase/sell a ticket and drop it off at the Pro Shop, we will review it and remove you from the event.** We would love to have 100% participation, but we understand that is not always possible.

I personally wish we didn't have to have fund raisers to help with our expense. I encourage each member to recruit a new member. This will get our membership where it needs to be, and we can thrive.
