Professionally he played a leading role in award winning government projects and in the development of private practice in architecture and urban design. He has led a number of visionary property development projects including the establishment of new company branch offices. This includes the establishment of his first practice Loughton Munsie Jeffery and Jodrell Architects in Australia, it grew from the vision of a four-partner socially committed architectural practice to a team of 16 in eight years.

He also nurtured the development of a faith-based group's local initiative, it gained a grant of 10 acres of land and developed a complex committed to community needs and teaching.

Colin has been involved in research; lectures and seminars internationally most recently in England and Wales. He and his colleagues in London and Australia have been instrumental in advancing research and development in; the environment; education; transport; and forms of accommodation. His practice in Perth developed the first Alzheimer's clinic/hostel in Australia and were the leading practice in the provision of aged person's care.
