Squantz Pond State Park

Squantz Pond immerses the visitor in a “mountain like” setting. Steep, wooded slopes disappear into the cool, blue pond below. In the fall, the park becomes a haven for photographers capturing the colorful reflection of the foliage in the mirrored surface of the water. In 1926 Squantz Pond was established as a state park.

The Town of New Fairfield operates a town park and boat launch on Candlewood Lake. Access to the town boat ramp is restricted to New Fairfield residents only.
