

RCS WiFi Keypad

Revenue Control Systems ON-SITE access controllers have an optional capability that allows customers to use their cell phone to enter a facility with just one click from up to 25 feet away from the keypad. No need to type a code into the actual keypad.

The RCS WiFi Keypad connects to the “wiegand” port on the On-Site Keypad controller board and allows customers to enter their code via a phone app as they drive up to the entry gate. The customer will simply save the application to their home screen on their device and enter their code. The app will save the customers passcode and all they have to do is press the ‘Send Code’ button in the app when they are near the keypad. There is no need to enter their code on the physical keypad.



- The RCS WiFi Keypad is only compatible with RCS On-Site Keypad brand.
- The WiFi Keypad device is housed inside the keypad enclosure. The faceplate of the unit will remain the same.
- User codes will be processed by the system as if they were typed into the actual keypad.
- Codes can be 1 to 10 digits long.
- Read range is approximately 25 feet.
